

WDSC's Plan for our outdoor season will be guided by Ontario Soccer Association's Return to Play Zones. This is a document that was created using the Green, Yellow, Orange, Red and Grey (Lockdown) categories that the Ontario Government transitioned to in Fall 2020.

Starting February 1, 2021 we will open registration for our outdoor season, but payment will not be taken at this time, you will merely be "holding" a spot for your player until such time that we can confirm the plan for the season. Requests for payments will begin April 15th and will need to be completed by April 30th to finalize your space. We are also forgoing our typical "Early Bird Pricing" this year and will be charging only the early bird pricing structure.

The following chart will help guide you with our plans for play for each age division, depending on the Zone category that the Region of Waterloo is in at the start of the season.

Refund Policy:

Payment will not be requested until 4 weeks prior to the season beginning, therefore we would hope we have a good idea of what our season will look like at that time, as well as would ask for a commitment from the players by this time.

Any refunds requested after payment has been made will be subject to a \$25 administration fee.

Due to the unique circumstances, there will not be official uniform pick up nights this year, uniforms will be distributed to the coaches in advance of the first night of play. Any requests for refunds once the season has begun will be charged a \$20 uniform fee in addition to the administration fee.

If public health guidelines change during the season and we have to cancel all future games and practices, there will be a prorated refund, minus \$20 to cover the costs of the uniform.

Please understand that there are fixed costs we have to pay for each season, regardless of how many weeks we are able to offer. These fixed costs include uniforms, equipment and insurance.
